## Atlanta Youth Chapter Launches a New Learning Journey

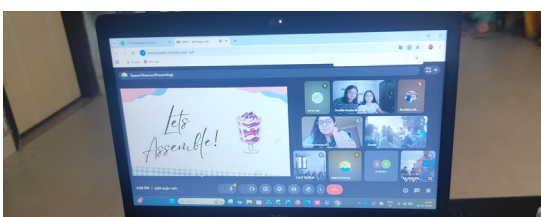
Sometimes, meaningful change begins with young minds coming together across continents.

The academic year concluded on a proud note as students across Polar, Taraori, Siwan, and Kanhai delivered exceptional performances in their school examinations. Twenty-nine students secured positions among the top three ranks in their respective classes, with strong performances across all centres.

In keeping with our tradition of recognising holistic growth, celebrations soon followed across centres. From handwriting and neatness to science, maths, sports, and nature awareness, Shiksha Prayas continues to acknowledge every effort that shapes confidence and character. This year, nearly 80 medals were awarded by



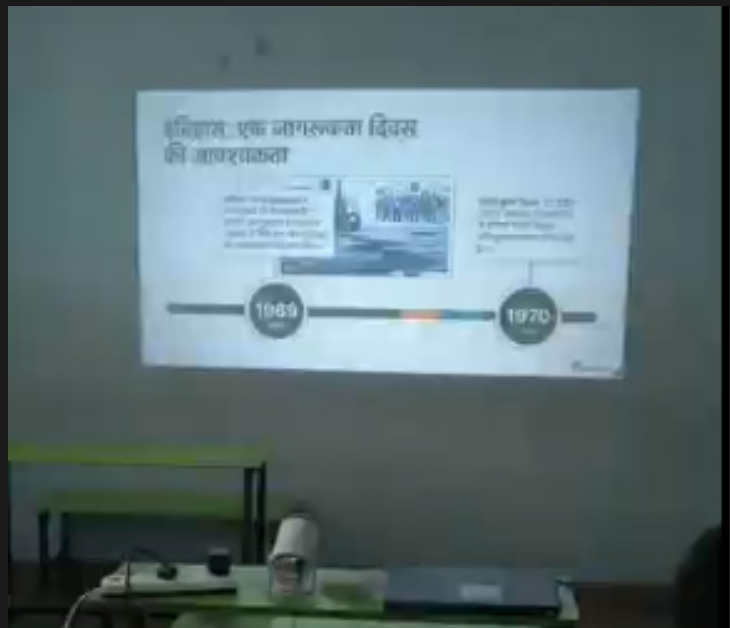
